A big yarding of mixed quality prime lambs followed the schedule trends easing moderately with space at a premium

Smaller yarding of prime sheep with prices easing by \$3 per head across all grades.

Store Lambs

Ewes with lambs at foot all counted made up most of the store pens. Demand was still strong with smaller lines selling extremely well up to \$130 per head and a bigger line of mixed age Romney ewes with black face lambs made \$111 per head.

Prime Cattle - 147

Good quality 600kg Hereford/Friesian cross steers sold for \$2.85 to \$2.90 per kg. 500 to 550kgs were at similar values. Heifers at 580 to 610 kgs made from \$2.85 to \$2.93 per kg. Friesian cows made \$1.65 to \$1.82 per kg and bulls at 630 kgs made \$2.78 per kg.

Store Cattle - 220

The Miller family's annual draft of 2 year old Angus/Friesian cross store cattle sold up to \$1380 per head. Angus/Friesian cross heifers made \$1110 per head with Friesian steers at \$1110 per head. A poor quality yarding of yearling dairy cattle were difficult to sell. Yearling Friesian steers at 364kgs made \$850 per head, poorer types made \$350 to \$450 per head.
