## **Prime & Store Cattle**

Although it was a small yarding of Primes & Stores at Coalgate, the price is still rising with only 1 pen out of the Prime Steers & Heifers going under the \$3.00 mark. The rest were well over \$3.00. The top pen of Charolais x Steers fetched \$3.36. The Heifers also sold well with the tops fetching \$3.37. Cows & Bulls were limited today with just 2 Bulls in the sale, a Wagyu weighing 395kg made \$2.58, and the Shorthorn Bull weighing in at 760kg made \$3.22. The Cows were all well over \$2.00, ranging from \$2.07 - \$3.26.

The Store market is on the lift with 2-year-old Beef x Heifers making \$1240 and Calves making \$500 - \$670.
