Prime & Store Cattle

The Prime market held again today with another week of quality consignments of Prime Cattle. Traditional Steers ranged from \$3.40 - \$3.60, while the Prime Heifers ranged from \$3.38 - \$3.58. A range in condition made for a varied market of Prime Cows with the pick of them reaching \$2.52 & ranging down to \$2.20.

There was a smaller line of Yearlings this week with the best of the yearling Angus & Angus Hereford x Steers at 293kg reaching \$1150 and Angus Hereford x Heifers at 320kg reached \$1000.
