**Prime & Store Cattle**

Prime Cattle vendors were very well rewarded for their Beef today. The heaviest Steers made \$2600, 653kg \$3.98/kg. Several pens of well finished Cattle made \$3.90 - \$3.98, we couldn't quite crack the \$4.00.

The Heifer market was similar to the Steers ranging from \$3.85 - \$3.98 for the best of them. Friesian x Heifers made \$3.20 at 352 kgs.

Cows sold at levels we have never seen, Beef cows made \$2.90 - \$3.21 and Friesian Cows made \$2.80 - \$2.92.

Bulls were sought after, 500 – 700 kg Bulls made \$3.74 - \$3.91.

In the Stores 2yr Murray Grey Friesian x Steers 390 – 413kg made \$3.53/kg, \$1390 - \$1460. Timata Farming, Mayfield yarded an impressive number of Charolais x Yearlings with their 80 Steers ranging from \$1180 - \$1420, \$3.60/kg and the 64 Heifers ranged from \$1030 - \$1300, also \$3.60/kg. All the yarded Store Cattle sold very well.
